Dear Mr. Scott Rosselli:

On February 26, 2009, I contacted you to request an estimate to put a new roof on my house. You sent someone to my house the next day and called me to discuss this matter.

You found that my roof had been ripped off by someone sent by my mortgages company and that the "roofers" who had been sent by the mortgage company were doing the work incorrectly. There were a number of errors, as well as violations of the building codes.

Furthermore, these alleged "roofers" had not obtained a building permit from the county, nor had they properly put tarps on the roof, to prevent weather damage, when they were caught in the act of working on my roof, without my permission or knowledge, by the Hardyston Construction official, Joe Butto, on February 13, 2009.

You gave me an estimate for the roof and explained exactly what was included in that price. I made numerous calls on February 27, 2009, to the three roofing businesses that I had contacted, asking questions about the work and the materials involved in the process.

Each time, you returned my calls promptly and answered all my questions and explained everything clearly, in terms that I could understand.

I asked for an estimate to put tarps on the roof. You told me approximately \$400. I had also asked the other roofing businesses about putting tarps on my roof. They were reluctant to do this, unless I signed a contract with them to do the roof also.

Therefore, I decided to hire you to put the tarps on my roof and to put the new roof on my house as well. This was about 4:30 p.m., and you promptly sent a crew out to my house, before we were even off the phone, and had the tarps in place by 5:00 p.m.

Although all three roofing businesses I contacted had been professional about their estimates and knowledgeable in their line of work, I felt that Rosselli Roofing and Siding was the most sincere, honest, and knowledgeable about their work.

Rosselli Roofing was the only one to mention to me that a portion of the siding would have to be removed, in order to do a certain section of the roof properly, and to prevent possible leaks in the future. 
The crew finished about 5:00 p.m. that evening and cleaned up all the debris in the yard.
